

On the 23rd July 1806. I accompanied the Deputy
 Superintendent General of Indian Affairs to the
 Council house at Fort George, with the Officers
 whose Names are mentioned in the proceedings
 of that day, and that what he states there to
 have passed in my presence, and the Officers
 therein mentioned, I do certify to be the case. I do
 also certify, that on the 24th of the same Month,
 that I went up to the Quarters of the Deputy
 Superintendent General, accompanied by the
 Officers of the different Corps whose names are
 mentioned in said proceedings, to the Number
 of Twelve, and that after waiting some time
 the Interpreter returned from the Camp of the
 Indians with the answer therein mentioned.
 Not being present at any of the former, or
 latter proceedings, I can say nothing on
 the subject.
