Edenvale: Washed in at 11:00 hrs. Visibility and ceiling unlimited. Wind SE at 12 mph. Washed out at 15:15 hrs. Flying time 11:00 hrs. Holy Communion was celebrated in the lounge at 08:00 hrs. Communicants of all denominations were invited to attend. The General Service for all Protestant Personnel was held at 11:15 hrs. in the Station Theatre. Catholic Services: Early Mass was held at 07:00 hrs with F/L Gavard in attendance. A church parade was also held in the lounge at 11:15 hrs.
