MEMO

Dear Sir,

A number of your Indians - a dozen or more - came in here this afternoon - not at any invitation from me & therefore as a surprise. It seems they imagined they were going to play football with the pupils here.

As they seem to have no permit from you to be absent from the Reserves, and as I have no wish to lay myself open to the charge of having been instrumental in keeping them from their work & duties on the reserves without your sanction, I have refused to allow them to play this afternoon. I consider you would have been justified in making the charge above had I allowed it.

If you think it advisable you might let me know whether you approve of a team coming in on Saturday next.
