In reply to your letter of the 7th instant, I beg to say that in all cases where a medical man is appointed on salary to attend Indians he is expected not only to give his professional services to the Indians belonging to the Band placed directly under his charge but also to all Indians who happen to visit the neighborhood and be taken ill. Under the circumstances the Department does not propose paying your account for professional services rendered to the Indian, John B. Dominic..
