- Q.83 Did you own your own house before you enlisted?
A.83 Yes sir.
- Q.84 You told us the water system was blocked up, I do not see how that could happen?
A.84 The water comes down back of the house. There is an underground pipe.
- Q.85 You have no motor to pump it?
A.85 No sir.
- Q.86 Was your house in good repair when you enlisted?
A.86 No sir, that is the evidence I have sent for.
- Q.87 Did your wife owe any money when you came back?
A.87 She may have owed some for things she bought.
- Q.88 Did you ever apply for farm or compassionate leave?
A.88 No sir.
