be paid from Kincolith Trust Funds or from money obtained from the Granby Smalter Co. for damage to timber I beg to inform you that a settlement of this matter will soon be made but it will depend on whether the Kincolith Indians will give the Company a release from any further damage claim. This was taken up with Mr. Indian arent Collison on October 17th last with the request that he meet the Kincolith Council and discuss the matter. Mr. Collison stated that he could not do this until the end of Hovember as most of the Indians were sway from home. Therefore if the Indians are home now there is no good reason why this meeting cannot be held and a decision arrived at as it is my desire to obtain a settlement at as early a date as possible.
