On Amalgamation of the Medical Faculties.

The following Report embodies the recommendations of the Sub-Committee on Amalgamation of the Medical Faculties, as amended by the Joint Committee on Federation in order to meet certain objections and representations made by the respective Medical Faculties through their representatives sitting with the said Joint Committee. The report so amended, as given hereunder, constitutes the agreement reached by the said Joint Committee in regard to the Amalgamation of the Medical Faculties in connection with the proposed Federation of Trinity University with the University of Toronto.

To the Chairman and Members of the Conjoint Committee on the proposal of Medical Faculty Amalgamation.

GENTLEMEN:

Your Sub-Committee have had two meetings and have carefully considered the personnel of the two Faculties with a view to recommending those members, who in the opinion of the Sub-Committee are best qualified, all things being considered, for the various positions, and beg to report the list of the proposed United Faculty.

It should be borne in mind that both Faculties in agreeing to this report will be making serious sacrifices because of their earnest desire to promote the best interests of Medical Education in Ontario by unifying the diverse interests in Toronto, and begs hereby to urge a very strong claim upon the Government to aid them in this aim in every way in their power. Par-
