

ZUCCH' RO, FEDERIGO.

Born at St. Angelo in Vado in 1513. He spent the early years of his life in Rome. In 1574 he arrived in England and was commissioned by Queen Elizabeth to paint her portrait and those of several of her courtiers.

ZURBARAN, FRANCISCO.

Born at Encante de Cantos, near Seville, and was a disciple of Pablo Roelas, and soon acquired the reputation of an eminent painter of history. He was invited to visit Madrid and was appointed painter to the King. He was a great favorite with Philip IV., in whose service he died.
