

tution when necessary, and for all other necessary purposes. In the event of the annual meeting not being held on the said last Monday in October, it shall be held as soon thereafter as possible, and the Secretary-Treasurer shall, within three days from the said last Monday in October, notify the members of the Association, in writing, that such annual meeting did not take place, and of the time and place at which it will be held. The officers appointed at the last annual meeting, or since appointed by the Committee, shall hold office till their successors are appointed.

XIII.—Special Meet'ngs.

The Secretary-Treasurer shall call a Special Meeting of the Association on receiving a written requisition asking him to do so, signed by ten members of the Association, and shall give at least two days notice, in writing or otherwise, of such meeting, to each member of the Association, and shall state in such notice the purpose or purposes for which such meeting is called, and no other business shall be transacted at such meeting than that specified in the notice.

XIV.—Committee Meetings.

The Chairman, or any two members of the Committee can call a Committee meeting by giving one day's notice to the other members of the Committee.

XV.—Requisitions.

All requisitions shall be in writing, and shall state the purpose for which they are signed, and all, except those requiring the Secretary-Treasurer to call a special meeting, shall be directed to the Chairman of the Committee.
