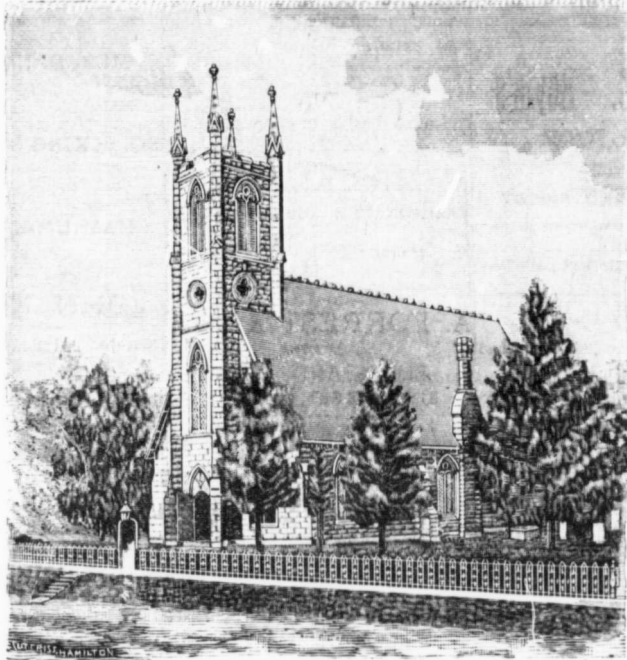

SERVICES.

SUNDAY,—11 a. m. and 7 p. m.
HOLY COMMUNION,—1st and 3rd Sundays.
Mid-day celebration, 2nd, 4th and 5th Sundays.
Early celebration, (8 a. m.)

All other days for which a service is provided in the Book of Common Prayer are observed, notice of such being given in church the previous Sunday
SUNDAY SCHOOL,—2.50 p. m.

Holy Baptism,—On the third Sunday at 4.15 p. m., or at any time when service is held in the church, provided notice be given in due season.

Churchings,—(See service for the same.) Before early celebration of Holy Communion, or before any Sunday or Wednesday evening service. (Notice must be given.)

Funerals must not be held on Sunday, except in rare cases of emergency.

Marriages cannot be "solemnized" in private houses.
