

*An act for granting a Bounty for growing and Cultivating Hemp in this Island for the purpose of Exportation.*

Ordered on Motion of Mr. Palmer; That the House do resolve itself into a Committee of Privileges and Elections of the whole House, to take into consideration the merits of the Petition of James Curtis, Esq. complaining of an undue Election and Return for Queens County; Alex. M'Donell, Esq. in the Chair.

On Motion of Mr. Macgowan, Ordered, That the House do the first thing to-morrow morning enter into a Committee of the whole house to take into consideration the Bill, entitled, "An Act for ascertaining, laying out, and fixing the Lines and Boundaries of three Counties, and of the different Townships into which this Island is divided, and for more readily adjusting all differences between Parties, when it appears that a settlement or improvements have been made by mistake on one Township for another, and also for raising by assessment a sufficient Fund out of which to defray the expences of ascertaining, laying out and fixing the said Boundary Lines."
