Passe Partout Ideas.

A few years ago the fad for encasing postcards, photographic prints pictures cut from magazines and other pictorial material within a narrow strip of black, brown or gold passe partout, had an almost world-wide popularity. Like many another decorative device, it had its day and disappeared. Lately, however, the passe partout has been revived in a new and much more interesting guise. In the new passe partout so closely resembles a narrow beaded wood frame that it is difficult to detect it. This new effect is gotten in two ways: first by binding paper printed in imitation of the grain and color of different woods, and second, by the device of building up a base for the paper binding through these of strips of cardboard. Placed under the passe partout paper, in single strips, graduated strips, several strips placed on top of each other, a frame of an inch in depth can be achieved. The new paper come in imitation of Circassian walnut, mahogany, dull gold, forest green and ebony.

Fancy frames are formed by the plan of placing bits of embossed cardboard, cut in designs to imitate carving, between the passe partout paper and the cardboard padding. When a dull gold paper, for example, is pasted over a strip of cardboard on which raised designs have been placed, the effect is very much that of the carved dull gold frame. Beaded frames, and frames with a line of gold inside, are simple matters with the aid of these new variations of an old idea.

BRITISH SUBMARINES IN BALTIC

2 German Steamers Torpedoed

London—The sinking of two German steamships by a submarine, believed to be a Russian, is reported in a Reuter despatch from Stockholm. The steamships were the Kolga, Hamburg, for Stockholm, and the Bianca.

The steamships were torpedoed yesterday afternoon off the Swedish island of Landsort, in the Baltic. The Kolga was attacked at five p. m., being shelled by the submarine for twenty minutes. Two members of the crew were slightly injured. The Kolga was then torpedoed and sunk. Thirteen of the crew were picked up by a Swedish steamer. Four others, including the captain and second mate, are missing.

Half an hour later the Bianca was shelled and then torpedoed. The attack occurred in the same vicinity as that of Kolga. The captain was taken prisoner. Two members of the crew were injured slightly. They and other members of the crew were picked up by the vessel which rescued the men from the Kolga.

The Kolga, 2,086 tons gross and 260 feet long, was built in 1903, and is owned in Lubeck.

The Bianca was owned in Hamburg. Her gross tonnage was 1,054. She was built in 1907 and was 226 feet long.

London—A large number of British submarines are operating in the eastern and southern portions of the Baltic Sea, which is now ice free, says a despatch to the Exchange Telegraph Company from Copenhagen. It was one of these submarines which sank the German steamer Hera, the despatch adds.

Rimini, Italy, May 19—Serious damage was done here by the earthquake which shook Central Italy during the night of May 16 and 17.

Ten houses collapsed, and about a thousand dwellings, in all, were damaged, many of these so badly that the safety of those in them was endangered.

The municipal theatre and the under prefecture school buildings were cracked to an alarming extent and part of the church of Colonnella has fallen.

The Grand Duke is getting to be the big figure in the war news once more. Whatever happens in the West, the Turks can scarcely avoid decisive defeat this summer. When they are done, the Russians will have an army of veterans released for the work of pulling down Austria.
