

Synopsis of Canadian North-West Land Regulations.

THE sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may home stead a quarter serior of available Dominion land in Manutoba. Saskatche wan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lanua Agency or sub-Agency for the district. Earry by proxy may be made at any Dominion. Landa Agency (out not Sub-Agency,) on certain conditions.

Canais Agency (sat not sub-agency, or certain conditions.

Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live with a dine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, on certain conditions A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may bre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre.

Duties—Six months residence in each of three years after earning homestead patent; also 50 acres extra cultivation Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent; on certain conditions.

Asettler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain distracts. Price \$3.00 pe acre. Duties—Must reside six month outof three years, cultivate 50 acres and erect a house worth \$300.

The art of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rough, scrubby or tony land. Live stock may be substituted for cultivation under certain conditions.
