GEORGE VILLIERS, Duke of Buckingham, born 1592. The favorite of James I. who figured largely in the episode known as the "Spanish Match"—a scheme to marry Charles to the daughter of the King of Spain. BENJAMIN HARRISON born 1833. Twenty-third President of the United States and grandson of the ninth President. He failed to secure reelection in 1892.
GENERAL BOOTH died 1912, aged 83. The famous leader founded the Salvation Army in 1878 which, under his enthusiastic and eminently practical direction became an organization of world-wide influence.

Quite an Experience.

In a letter to his sister, under date August 9th, Tony Evans, formerly of this city, but now of New York, tells of an experience which he had on board the steamship Grand Republic on a trip from Rockaway Beach to New York. The ship almost meeting the same fate as that of the Eastland on the Chicago River some time ago. On board the Grand Republic were 3,300 persons, including men, women and children. A drunken brawl started and the passengers in their anxiety to see the fight rushed to the starboard side of the ship causing her to list heavily. With the sudden remembrance of the Eastland tragedy of a few weeks previous, the passengers became greatly excited and a panic ensued, the captain and officers having to draw revolvers to restore order. When the ship reached the pier over 100 lady passengers were taken ashore in an unconscious condition.
