Story of the British Navy.

ILLUSTRATED LECTURE BY COM-
MANDER FENN.

The Sunday Schoolroom of Gower St. Church was well filled last evening at the lecture on the British Navy given for the benefit of the Gower St. Troop of Boy Scouts by Commander Fenn of H. M. S. Briton. All who attended were delighted with the presentation of the subject. For an hour the Commander spoke on the Navy of the past, tracing the history from the earliest times, and recounting the story of many a heroic deed done by "hearts of oak" in the days of

wooden vessels and sail propulsion. The speaker was thoroughly acquainted with his subject and told of many incidents of striking interest. The latter part of the evening was given to the display of lantern slides on the Navy of to-day. The lecturer commented on these, and gave a description of the battle of Jutland and the attack on Zeebrugge. The exploits of the mine sweepers and the work of the submarines were touched upon, and the frequent applause and close attention of the audience—and especially the boy part of it—showed that the Commander had caught and was holding their entire attention. In the course of the evening allusion was made to the Battle of Trafalgar and the early life of Admiral Nelson. At

a later date the Commander has promised to give another lantern lecture on Nelson's life. This will doubtless attract a large audience. During the evening a dialogue was put on by two of the older Scouts, Bert Spencer, P. L. "Eagles", and Jim Stevenson, P. L. "Caribous". Mrs. Garland, wife of Assistant Scoutmaster Lieut. Chas. Garland, sang a solo, accompanied by Mrs. Jardine. A vote of thanks was moved by Mr. Joseph Peters and seconded by Rev. Dr. Bond. The Scouts and Cubs were there in force, and they presented their thanks to the speaker by giving him the full salute and the rousing Scout yell. His Excellency the Governor, Chief Scout of Newfoundland, regretted his inability to be present.
