STRICT ECONOMY TO BE FOLLOWED

Members of the Government Must Be Kept Down—Work Halted on Contracts.

Ottawa, Jan. 14.—Word has been sent to all the department heads that they are required to prepare their estimates for consideration by cabinet council at the earliest possible date and also that these estimates must be kept down to the lowest possible figure.

An intimation was also given to the deputy ministers, it is said, that they must expect to have their estimates cut down and that they must give proper service in the work they have to carry on.

Work on contracts awarded by the late government during the last few weeks it was in office has been halted by the King administration, it was learned last night, and contractors and others have been warned that there will be no further expenditures on those contracts until the new government is satisfied that the expenditures are both necessary and in keeping with the present financial conditions.
