V., be held at the Cathedral School, in Victoria, at eleven o'clock, forenoon, on **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 22ND, 1892**, for the purpose of electing a successor to the See.

By Canon of the Synod, no Lay Representative can take his seat unless all assessments due by the congregation he represents are paid.
