(6) The notation should be general or international; whilst using the English names for the pieces, the squares should be lettered and numbered in accordance with the continental board.

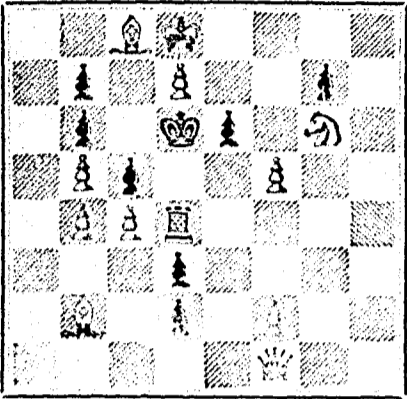
(7) The price of each part should not exceed shillings.
