Canadian Association of University Teachers of German (CAUTG) Workstudent Program

Occupations

Hotel and restaurant industry

Eligibility

To be eligible a student must:

- be a permanent resident of Canada;
- be studying at a post-secondary institution in Canada which has membership in the CAUTG;
- be between the ages of 18 and 30;
- have a working knowledge of German (at least one year of university German or the equivalent);
- not have participated in this program previously. (Students who have participated as DAAD award recipients in Freiburg are eligible.); and
- register before November 30.

Travel arrangements

Transportation from the student's home to Toronto may be subsidized by the Canadian government.

Program

The Canada-Germany (FRG) Young Workers Exchange Program

General

This program is designed for Canadian candidates who have graduated in disciplines related to Industry, Commerce, or Science and Technology.

Duration of training

From 6 to 18 months

Conditions for admission

Applicants must:

- be graduates of a university or have a post-secondary diploma or certificate from an institute of technology or equivalent educational institution;
- have a minimum of one year's working experience directly related to their academic degree or diploma;
- undertake their period of training in their own profession or trade;
- be 18 to 30 years of age; and
- have a working knowledge of German (certificate from a language teacher needed if German is not your mother tongue).
