Canadian Forces shall arrange for the procurement of materiel, equipment, installations, transportation, construction, maintenance, supplies, services and civil labour from private, commercial or government sources all in accordance with the procedures, terms and conditions applicable to such procurement for the Canadian Forces. Any significant change in the scale or scope of the support services provided to the Federal Republic of Germany by Canada shall be the subject of consultation between the two participants as soon as possible before the proposed change is due to be implemented in accordance with the terms of the appropriate Memorandum of Understanding.

6. The Federal Republic of Germany shall bear the costs of the training programmes of the German Armed Forces in Canada and shall share costs as agreed between users of the facilities in accordance with the arrangements set out in the relevant Memoranda of Understanding. These costs shall include costs for environmental studies, projects, undertakings or monitoring surveys as are required under Canadian laws, regulations and orders. Such arrangements,
