#### Section 4. Probable Duration of the Experiment

The experiment shall extend over a continuous period of about 100 days, commencing on or about 15 June 1974, with additional time prior to and after this period for the appropriate preparation and termination procedures.

#### Section 5. Co-operating Agencies

The designated Co-operating Agencies under the present Agreement shall be:

- (a) For the Organization: the Secretariat of the Organization
- (b) For Senegal: Minister of State for Public Works, Town Planning and Transport
- (c) For the other participating Member States: such national agencies as they shall designate in accordance with Section 17 below.

# Section 6. Privileges and Immunities of the World Meteorological Organization in Senegal

- (a) The Organization's juridical personality in Senegal shall be as provided for in Article II, Section 3, of the Convention on Privileges and Immunities of the Specialized Agencies to which the Government of Senegal has acceded and which it has applied to the Organization since 2 March 1966.
- (b) The privileges and immunities of officials of the Organization assigned to Senegal for the requirements of the Experiment shall be governed by the terms of that Convention.

#### Section 7. Title to Property

Title to all real property, and any improvements thereto, furnished, acquired, or constructed for the purpose of the Experiment and located in Senegal shall be vested in the Government of the Republic of Senegal at the end of the Experiment.

## Section 8. Authorization for Access to and Use of Facilities in Senegal

The Government of the Republic of Senegal authorizes for the whole duration of the Experiment the use, in so far as practicable, by the Organization and the other participating Member States, of the Regional Meteorological Centre and the Regional Telecommunication Hub of Dakar, as well as such airport, harbour and other facilities in Senegal as may be required for the purposes of the Experiment, and are listed in the "Protocole d'exécution", attached to this Agreement.

### Section 9. Entry and Departure of Vessels, Aircraft and Personnel

- (a) The Government of the Republic of Senegal shall, upon request take the necessary steps to facilitate entry into and departure from Senegal or its inland and territorial waters of the vessels, aircraft and personnel of the other participating Member States when such vessels, aircraft and personnel are assigned to or visit Senegal for the purposes of the Experiment.
- (b) Personnel of other participating Member States assigned to Senegal for the purposes of the Experiment, whose full identity has been notified sufficiently in advance, shall be provided with visas free of charge, on arrival at the airport or port of Dakar.
