

## Program for North American Mobility in Higher Education

Established in 1995, in accordance with the spirit of the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), this program aims to:

- support the development of academic co-operation and institutional linkages among universities, colleges, technical institutions and private businesses;
- improve the quality of human resource development, and explore ways of preparing students for work in the global economy;
- improve and increase student mobility, including recognition and portability of academic credits and the development of joint study programs;
- encourage the exchange of expertise in new developments in higher education and training, including the use of distance education.

Projects are undertaken by a consortia of universities, colleges and technical institutions. Participating students do not apply directly but are selected by the post-secondary institutions involved in a project under the program.
