An Act to amend the Public Service Superannuation Act, the Canadian Forces Superannuation Act, the Defence Services Pension Continuation Act, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Superannuation Act, the Diplomatic Service (Special) Superannuation Act, the Intercolonial and Prince Edward Island Railways Employees' Provident Fund Act

and the Canadian Corporation for the 1967 World Exhibition Act.

The Honourable Lucien Lamoureux, Speaker of the House of Commons, then addressed the Honourable the Deputy of His Excellency the Governor General as follows:
