Fourteen Petitions were laid on the Table.

Mr. Bennett, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House,—Statement of Returned Soldiers' Insurance, for the year ended 31 March, 1930.

Mr. Manion, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House,—Order in Council and Regulations passed under the provisions of "The Electricity and Fluid Exportation Act," Chapter 54, R.S.C. 1927.

Also,—Report of work done and expenditures made as of December 31, 1930, also Estimated Expenditures to be made in 1931, under authority of the Canadian National Railways Montreal Terminals Act, 1929, Chapter 12, Statutes of Canada, 1929.

He also laid before the House, by command of His Excellency the Administrator,—Twenty-sixth Annual Report of the Board of Railway Commissioners for Canada, for the year ended 31st December, 1930.
