Go straight from Winnipeg via Main street north to Selkirk—one road, and no one could miss it—a good clay road, but not passable after a shower.

At Selkirk, is a historic church and graveyard, as it is here all the old first settlers are buried. At St. Paul's, 2 miles further on, is an Indian Industrial School, carried on by the Episcopalian Church. At Lower Fort Garry is a stockaded fort yet used by the Hudson Bay Co. At Selkirk is a Lunatic Asylum and the Government Fish Hatcheries (the largest in the Dominion). A trip further north to the Indian Reserve might be interesting, especially if the tourist could arrive about the time "treaty money" was being paid.
