The Right Rev. Maurice S. Baldwin, D.D.,
BISHOP OF HURON.

THE subject of this brief memoir was born in Toronto on the 21st June 1836, and is the fourth son of the late JOHN SPREAD BALDWIN, and first cousin of the late Honorable ROBERT BALDWIN. He received his early education at the Upper Canada College, and graduated at Trinity College, Toronto. In 1860 he was ordained Deacon, by the late BISHOP CROMYX, and appointed to the Curacy of St. John's Church, St. Thomas. In 1862 he entered upon his first independent charge as Incumbent of St. Paul's Church, Port Dover, and in October 1865 accepted a call to the Incumbency of St. Luke's Church, Montreal. In January 1870, he received the appointment of Assistant Minister at Christ Church Cathedral, and in the month of June following was appointed one of its
