

Lower Canada and 2^d That such acquittances or a true copy or Duplicate of them be then deposited of record in the registry office to which it belongs for cancellation and as a justificative proof of such cancellation.

That, in case the new Tariff be recalled and not be enforced by law, the secretary of the association will call as soon as possible the committee of "Interpretation" named at Quebec the 7th of August last to make uniform interpretation and application of the existing Tariff and that such interpretation be printed and published instead of the new Tariff.

That the present resolutions be printed in both languages with the text of the Tariff for the guidance of the members of the said association.

That a certain number of said copies be allowed to each of the members of the present association and that the remainder be deposited with the secretary, to be by him sold for the profit and advantage of the association.

That the same thing be done with the Legal opinions given to Messrs. Auger and Sicotte at their special request for the benefit and advantage of the association.

That in and out of the funds in hands with the Treasurer, the bills of the lawyers for such opinions be paid as soon as possible and authority is hereby given to the Treasurer, to pay such bills which were made for the benefit of the association in having many and important questions decided relating to the interpretation and the law concerning the duties of the Registrar.
