

WHARF.

7.—No person shall obstruct the wharf by having a canoe or boat thereon or moored thereto.

BATHING.

8.—Bathing is allowed at all times, provided the bather be clothed from neck to knee in proper and decent costume. In going to and from the water, bathers must use the door and staircase specially provided for that purpose, at the eastern end of the Club House. Persons in bathing costume shall not go into any part of the Club House other than the dressing rooms. No one in bathing costume shall be allowed on the wharf.

CANOES,

9.—No person shall be allowed to use the Canoe, Boat, or other property of any member except upon producing a written order signed by the owner.

WAR CANOE.

10.—Regulations regarding the use of the war canoe, will be posted from time to time on the Club Bulletin Boards.

RACKS AND LOCKERS.

11.—Payment of dues for racks and lockers shall be made in advance.
