simili be filied by the Board of Directors. The Directors shall be chosen so that if possible a quorum shall live at the Head Office.

- Sec. 3. There shall also be appointed annually by the Board of Directors, at first meeting after the annual meeting, one member from each Lodge represented in the Association, who shall be termed a Local Director, who shall hold office for one year, or until his successor is elected.
- Sec. 4. The President shall preside at all the meetings of the Association and of the Board of Directors. He shail appoint, with the approval of the board of Directors, ail officers and committees not herein provided. He shali see that the laws and regulations of the Association arc faithfully executed. He shall not vote at any question hefore the Association or the Board of. Directors except at an election, or when there is a tie vote, then he shall have the casting vote. He shall sign ali the official papers and all orders drawn on the Treasurer by the Secretary, by order of the Board of Directors, or as provided by these laws, and have a general supervision of the books and accounts of the Secretary and Treasurer. He shall call such meetings as are provided for in Article IV.
- Sec. 5. The Vice-President shall exercise all the functions of the President during his absence from the Head Office.
- Sec. 6. The Secretary shall keep a record of all the transactions of the Association and the Board of Directors. He shall keep all the books of accounts; he shall receive all the moneys due
