## TRAVELING MEMBERS .- RITUALS.

II. A member desiring to visit a Division with the Traveling Password, Explanation and Card, shall cause the same to be announced to the W. P. through the I. S. The W. P. shall direct the P. W. P. to retire and examine the applicant in the Traveling Password and Explanation, and see that the Card is duly signed and sealed. The P. W. P., if satisfied, will so report to the W. P., who will direct the admission of the visitor in the usual form, except that no Password or Explanation is required.

III. A traveling member may be admitted on the Traveling Password and Explanation in use at the date of the Card.

IV. It shall be proper for a W. Patriarch to communicate the Traveling Password and Explanation to a P. W. Patriarch, and vice versa.

## Rituals.

A set of Ritual consists of one Blue Book and one set of Officers' Cards. No National or Grand Division Officer shall furnish to a Subordinate Division a second set, or duplicate parts thereof, unless their old ones are returned, or satisfactory assurance given that they are destroyed.

## Regalia.

To preserve uniformity, all Subordinate Divisions of the Sons of Temperance shall be known by their Regalia: White Collar, White Tassels, and Rosette
