TWO LIBERALS IN HAMILTON

Mr. Macpherson Holds His Seat by a
Majority of Twenty-Four

OVER THE VOTE FOR MR. BOVILLE.

Judge Snider Concludes His Tedious
Work of the Re-count.Judgment Handed Out at Eleven o'clock
Last Night—Crosses Placed in the Ob-
long Spaces After the Candidates' Names, Also Crosses in the Oblong as
well as the Disc were Counted—
In This Judge Macpherson's Ruling in
East York was Concurred in by the
Majority of the Re-count.Hamilton, July 8.—(Special).—The
long and tedious task of re-counting
the ballots was completed to-night at
11 o'clock. Judge Snider declared that
Messrs. Wood and Macpherson, Liber-
als, were elected. T. H. Macpherson's
majority over R. G. Boville was re-
duced from 88 to 24.The returning officer's figures were:
Barker 480, Boville 579, Macpherson
587, Wood 586; and the figures given
yesterday were: Barker 484, Boville
579, Wood, 587; Macpherson 579.There were these classes of ballots
reserved: Those in which the crosses
were placed in the oblong space, before
after or under the candidates' names;
those in which the crosses were placed
in the disc and also in the oblong
spaces; those which were numbered
and not initialed; those which contain-
ed the deputy returning officer's full
name; those which contained his ini-
tials and were also numbered; those
marked in ink; those marked with a
blue pencil; and those which con-
tained other marks or disfigurements
besides the crosses.In giving his decision upon these bal-
lots, His Honor said he would be in-
fluenced to a great extent by what he
considered was the elector's intention,
and endeavor as far as possible to
preserve the franchise. He would
quote no authority, as his object was
not to set an example for others, but
to act according to his own judg-
ment. In the act of 1895, he referred
made to where the cross should be

additionally those marked in both oblong
spaces and disc; those numbered in-
stead of initialed, as it was evident the

The Arguments.

After completing the task of count-
ing the ballots which were marked
correctly and contained no irregular-
ties which would cause any doubt as
to whether they should go or not, the
Judge Snider and the lawyers at-
tended last night till 9 o'clock this
morning, when the argument on the
reserved ballots began.The re-count gave Macpherson 58
more votes than Barker.

Marked Outside the Disc.

The first argument was on ballots
marked outside of the disc.Y. V. Petrol, Q. C., for Mr. Mac-
pherson, argued that schedule M, on
which Judge Macpherson had based
his decision in the Hamilton case, did
not apply in this re-count, the in-
terpretation of the act being that the
ballots marked outside of the disc were
