Boom in Wheat—Toronto Price Goes Up 3 Cents.

SALE OF MANITOBA WHEAT.

The sale is reported of a lot of 20,000 bushels of No. 3 hard Manitoba wheat in store here at 75c and No. 1 hard is quoted at 81c in store here.

About a month ago, not more than 60c could have been obtained for the above lot. This sudden found it profitable to wait a month for a gain of \$2,000.—Montreal Trade Bulletin.

LATEST ON CHIEFS.

Last week was a very active one in cheese, and the amount of business on spot was very heavy, sales being reported at market aggregating between 30,000 and 35,000 boxes, the Wholesale Co-operative Supply Association alone buying 10,000 boxes. This week the demand has been less active, but none the less firm, sales being reported at us within the past few days of 12,000 to 14,000 boxes, consisting of the western September and October grades, 10 5-cs, and finest eastern at 10 1-4c to 10 3-8c, also under grades ranging from 8c to 10 1-8c. Liverpool cable quotes 8c to 9c, while sales have been made at 5 1/2c to 5 3/4c, c. i. f. Advances from the west state that buyers are rattling away and taking all the finest western they can get at 10 1-4c, and as high as 10 3-8c is said to have been paid.

The total exports from Montreal up to the close of last week were 1,243,833 boxes against 1,238,422 boxes for the corresponding period last year, showing an increase of 45,000 boxes.—Trade Bulletin.

Today's attendance was large, and equal to last Saturday. There seemed to be a good demand for oats, and sales ranged from 4c to 5c higher. Receipts were smaller than usual. New sold at 46c to 55c, and old at 60c to 65c.

Wheat receipts were light, and the demand steady; the usual prices paid were \$1.15 to \$1.20 per cwt.

Only a few lots of peas came in. The demand was good and values steady at 55c to 75c per cwt.

Barley in good demand, but not much offered; no change in price.

Vegetables were quite plentiful, and prices reasonable. Potatoes brought 32c to 40c per bag; onions, 50c per bag, and pickling onions, 20c per bag.

The display of celery, carrots, cabbage, squash, etc., was good; some exceedingly pretty specimens of each were to be seen.

Butter was steady at 14c to 15c, and eggs at 15c to 16c. The demand for both was good and the supply fair.

Dressed hogs steady at \$5 to \$5.25. Beef and lamb in good supply, and values unchanged.

Very little hay offered; the demand was good; sales at \$7.50 to \$8.

Straw quiet at \$2.50 to \$3 by the load.
