B. W. Snow says: "The government report fully confirms the substantial failure of the spring wheat crop for the west. It makes the crop of Minneapolis and the Dakotas only 91,000,000 bushels, against 285,000,000 last year. From the northwest crop. after deducting about 20,000,000 bushels of Durum wheat and the 22,000,000 required for seed, there is left a total available supply of spring wheat production of 49,000,000. The feed requirement of population of three states for a year equals about 21,000,000 bushels, so that the surplus production of spring wheat this year in the three states is only about 28,000,000 bushels, against 222,000,000 last year."
