The first part of this month will be temperately warm and settled. On the 7th rain will fall heavily; from that period to the 10th, changeable weather, with frequent showers of rain; after which, the weather will again become settled and warm, which will last, with almost no intermission, until the 21st, when the heat will considerably increase, with heavy cloud, weather. On the 23d a severe thunder storm will occur, attended with tremendous squalls of wind. On the 24th the weather will again clear up & remain so to the end of the month, beginning with temperate hears, but gradually increasing in strength every day.
