

ECLIPSES.

There will be four Eclipses this year, as follows:—

I. A partial Eclipse of the Moon April 10th, at midnight, visible in this Island. Eclipse commences 11h. 51m.; ends 1h. 37m. morning of the 11th. Size $2\frac{1}{2}$ digits, or about one-fifth of the Moon's diameter.

II. A total Eclipse of the Sun April 25th, invisible in North America, but visible in most of South America and Africa.

III. A partial Eclipse of the Moon October 4th, in the evening, visible. The beginning of the Eclipse occurs before the Moon rises. The middle of the Eclipse will be at 6h. 46m. and ending at 7h. 47m. Size $4\frac{1}{2}$ digits, or about one-third of the Moon's diameter.

IV. An annular Eclipse of the Sun October 19, in the morning, visible throughout the Island as a partial eclipse, commencing at 9h. 51m., and ending at 1 o'clock.
