

- A.74 Yes.
- Q.75 What did the soldiers do when they saw an officer running towards the Post?
- A.75 They started to run to run towards their Posts.
- Q.76 Could you observe them as they continued running?
- A.76 No. They disappeared from view.
- Q.77 When did you see a soldier at No.1 A.A.Post?
- A.77 I saw a soldier arrive at the Post when Mr.Jones arrived there.
- Q.78 What did the soldier at the Post do?
- A.78 He re-entered the post.
- Re-examined by the Prosecutor.
- Q.79 Do you know of any reason why soldiers not on duty should run from the position at which they were at,near the fence, if they were not on duty?
- A.79 No,Sir.
- Questioned by the Court.
- Q.80 You state that the soldier at No.1.A.A.Post wore a steel helmet?
- A.80 Yes,Sir.
- Q.81 When the soldiers ran,did they disappear from view before you saw the soldier arrive at the Post?
- A.81 Yes,Sir.
- Q.82 Is the accused the soldier you saw arrive at the Post at the time Mr. Jones arrived there?
- A.82 I do not know,Sir.

### Third

Witness for Prosecution. B78675 A/Sgt.R.J.Wensley, No.2 Platoon Commander, H.Q.Company Irish Regiment of Canada.(CA) being duly sworn,is examined by the Prosecutor.

- Q.83 Will you tell the Court in your own words what happened at approximately 1700 hours 5th of March,1942?
- A.83 Shortly before 1700 hours on March 5th 1942,I warned the accused, Private L.J.Green and also William Bellinger,to go on guard at Numbers 1 and 2 A.A.Posts for their tour of duty of two hours. As is customary I saw them half way to their Posts. And,quite certain they would continue to their Posts,I returned to my quarters and went to supper about 1730 hours. Shortly afterwards Mr.Jones sent for me and ordered me to place Green and Bellinger under ~~xxxxx~~ close arrest. This I did.
- Q.84 You are Platoon Commander of # 2 Platoon?
- A.84 Yes Sir.
- Q.85 Is the accused a member of your platoon?
- A.85 Yes,Sir.
- Q.86 What are the specific duties of No.2 Platoon?
- A.86 To man the A.A.Posts.
- Q.87 What is the role of these A.A.Posts?
- A.87 The guarding of New Wellington Barracks against surprise attack from the air.
- Q.88 How long had your platoon been doing that duty previous to March 5th,1942?
- A.88 About two weeks.
