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AFTERNOON SESSION.

FRIDAY, JUNE 13th, 1890.

The Medical Council met at 8.30 p.m. Friday, 13th June in accordance with motion for adjournment. President in the chair.

Registrar called the roll, all present excepting Sir James Grant, Doctors Henry, Johnson, MacArthur, Philip, Rosebrugh and Ruttan. Minutes of last meeting read and confirmed.

Moved by Dr. Bergin, and resolved, That the Registrar be directed to place himself in communication with the authorities of the Canadian and British universities and medical colleges, and obtain their views thereon, and also obtain curricula of the leading universities on the continent of Europe, and further that a committee be appointed to whom shall be submitted the information so obtained, said committee to frame a report, a copy of which shall be supplied to each member of the Council at least two weeks in advance of the next annual meeting. Carried.

Moved by Dr. Thorburn, seconded by Dr. Johnson, that the following be the committee to consult the Registrar as per above:

Doctors Bray, Bergin, Thorburn, Johnson and Oliphant.

Moved by Dr. Bergin, seconded by Dr. Bray, that this Council do petition the Legislature of Ontario, for power to increase the annual fees payable by each member of the college and for power to erase from the Register the names of all members who fail to pay the annual dues; such names to be restored upon payment of fees, dues; the Legislative committee to consist of Doctors Thorburn, Day, Bergin, Oliphant. Carried.

Yeas and Nays demanded and recorded as follows:
