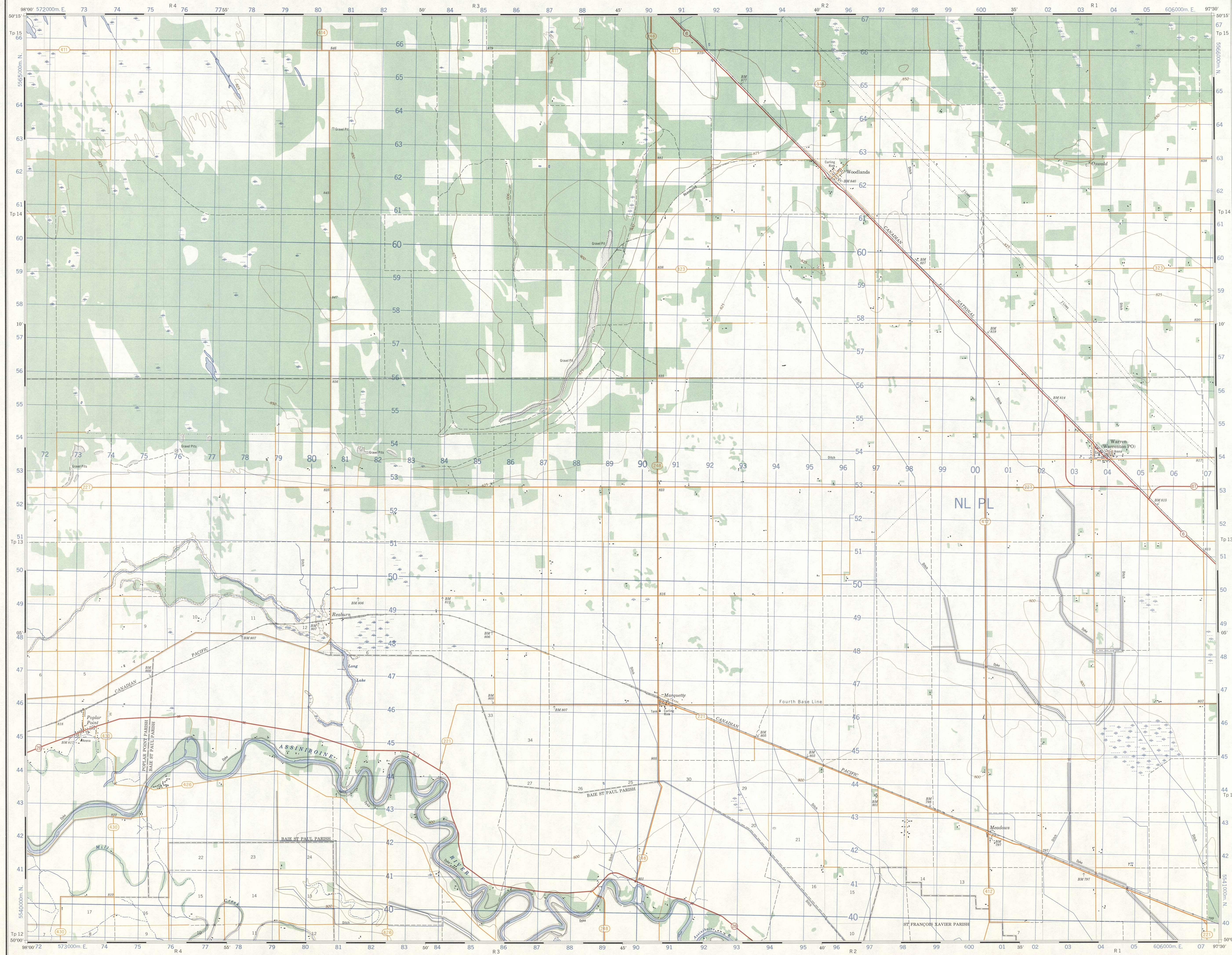

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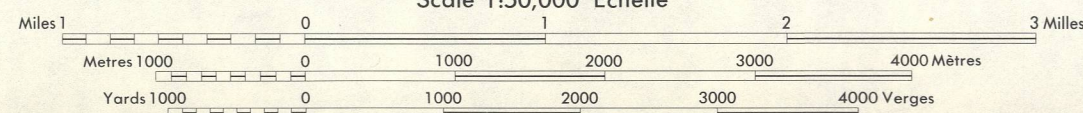

EXAMPLE OF METHOD USED
TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES
THE FOLLOWING GRID REFERENCE IS A SIMPLE ONE
AND DOES NOT REFER TO A POINT ON THIS MAP

99	98	97	96
98	97	96	95
97	96	95	94
96	95	94	93

REFERENCE POINT CHURCH (see above)

EASTING: Road number on grid line immediately to left of point
Estimate tenths of a square from this line westward to point

NORTHING: Road number on grid line immediately below point
Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point

EXAMPLE: MILITARY GRID REFERENCE 979884
Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 63 miles)
