Bolsheviki Carrying On War in North

PENETRATE TOWN OF SRED-MAKREGNA, BUT ARE DRIVEN OUT BY COUNTER-ATTACK.

Archangel, Tuesday, Feb. 11.—Bolshevik forces have resumed the offensive in the region of Sredmakregna. For a brief time last night the Bolsheviks occupied several allied blockhouses after penetrating the town, but they were driven out by a British and Russian counter-attack. The fighting continued today.

Patrol activity continues on the Kadish sector, but the American, British and Russian troops maintained the gains made in the offensive last week.
