accrued thereon, remain unpaid, and it is expedient to enable Her Majesty to obtain reimbursement of such sums of money and rates of insurance, in the same manner as if they had been paid by the said Commissioners:

Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

Money paid by the Receiver General for insurance on houses built with loan, to be reimbursed by the borrowers.

That all persons who may have entered into any 5 bonds or obligations, or who may now or hereafter be in any manner or way legally bound by any bonds or obligations entered into in pursuance of the said act as aforesaid, in which such clauses as aforesaid have been inserted, shall be thereby bound to reimburse to Her Majesty what-10 ever sums of money or rates of insurance may heretofore have been paid by Her Majesty's Receiver-General for this province as aforesaid, in the same manner and to the same extent as the same persons would would have been or would be bound to reimburse the same, if paid by the 15 said Commissioners before their powers and authorities ceased and determined as aforesaid, any thing in the said Act, or in the said or any other clauses of any such bond or obligation to the contrary notwithstanding.
