Dear Mr. Scott,-

I am in receipt of a letter from Mr. John M. Greer, lumber dealer, Sucker Lake, Township of Madora, close to the township of Gibson. In this letter he intimates that information has reached him that the Indian Department are about to dispose of timber on the Gibson Reserve. I think that he is likely misled with regard to this. I would like to ask you whether it is the intention of the Government to dispose of the timber in that locality, and if so, would like to have all the particulars.

If I understand the matter correctly, only one-half of the township of Gibson is being held by the Indian Department for the Indians of the Gibson Reserve. If so, I presume the other
