OTTAWA, 28th April, 1903.

Sir,

I beg to call your attention to official letter of the 17th March last in which you were informed that 50 Patton Star Glass-lined fire extinguishers were shipped to you on the 16th February and to request that you will be good enough to report how many reached you and in what condition they arrived. If any damage was done in transit, please state whether it is of such a nature as to call for the machine being replaced or repaired in Winnipeg, and if so the cost of such repairs. The Department also wishes to know the number of bulbs received for the machines and their condition, and the number of extra bulbs subsequently received. As the Department is anxious to close this transaction with Mr Patton, I should be glad if you would give this matter your early attention.
