Quoted Mr Mackenzie King as say<sup>ing</sup> that objective ~~of~~ C246376-A  
Canada was the overthrow of National Socialism in Germany  
and not Germany itself. This, said the announcer, was in  
flat contradiction with the officially declared aims of  
France which meant the destruction of the Reich. Announcer  
also quoted the Prime Minister as saying that ~~Canada~~  
Canada intended to participate in post-war peace negotiations  
and would oppose ~~such~~ such another injustice as the  
Treaty of Versailles. Canada, the Prime Minister was further  
quoted as saying, had no desire to make sacrifices which  
would only lead to new conflicts.

If those were the views of the Prime Minister of  
Canada, the announcer continued, "we are entitled to ask  
for what reason Canada is taking part in the European war  
at all." Why, then, should the blood of French-Canadians  
be shed?"
