Sir,

With reference to accounts for medical attendance on Indians; I have the honor to inform you that, in future, you will be required to see that clear satisfactory explanations are given in the column for remarks, in the statement accompanying the voucher, of each individual case attended.

If an Indian is attended off his Reserve, the fact must be given, and his location stated, as well as the reason for his being absent.

If full particulars were given in all cases of expenditure connected with your Agency, fewer vouchers would be returned, and there would be less correspondence in reference thereto. Items of the smallest importance are just as necessary to be explained as those of great account.
