SECTION 15(1)

ARMY ACT

in that he

at Toronto, Ontario, at 1400 hours on the 20th day of February, 1945, absented himself without leave from Chorley Park Military Hospital, Royal Canadian Army Medical Corps, C.A., Toronto, Ontario, and remained so absent until he was apprehended by Military Authorities at Odessa, Ontario, at 0945 hours on the 5th day of March, 1945, dressed in military uniform.

The cost of apprehension and return to his Unit was in the amount of eleven dollars and twelve cents (\$11.12).
