

Second witness for prosecution

1857 A/Sgt Brennan L.S. known states: -

I am 1857 A/Sgt Brennan L.S. of the same unit as the accused.

I recall the card game in question on the date mentioned.

I remember Sgt Seibel had a lighter.

The hell for supper went downstairs. As a result of what Sgt Seibel told me then we both went to the accused and asked him whether he had seen the lighter when it had been left. We asked him because he was last seen on that floor. I went with Seibel then & we asked the rest of the men, but without success.

I know the lighter was on the shelf behind Seibel because we were both using it.

I positively testified I worked in relation to the one which was on the shelf.

Cross Examination states:

When the supper bell rang they usually all go down at the same time.

The accused had been playing in that game but he was not playing at supper time - Questioned by J.A. :-

I can't remember whether he was there at supper time but he was watching part of the time.
