

RE-EXAMINED BY THE PROSECUTOR

- A. The six bottles were placed there by myself, I know that Pte Erisson had taken drinks outside of that and before that.
- WBB 2.0 Q. Apart from ~~there~~ ^{that} you stated there was one bottle left and if I can figure four glasses to the bottles, that is 20 glasses. How many friends were in the Car Park with Erisson, how many drinking with him?
- A. There was just one friend, a clerk and he had one glass.

JA: Capt Menard, that is getting very close to cross-examination, Duguay is your witness, you may not cross-examine him. You are entitled to re-examination to ask him questions to explain what has been brought out in cross-examination.

Pros: It was brought out in cross-examination.

JA: If you get into an argumentative question with him you are cross-examining him.

- Q. Would you be able to recognize this jar of liquor - how would you be able to recognize this jar of liquor, by what?
- A. The jar was very easy to recognize, I call tell it from the straw covering alone, it also had markings and paint on it also by the crack.
- Q. How many jars of liquor are there in that place?
- A. There were three jars but only one full.

- Q. Was the glass you were drinking from - was it that size or would it be bigger?
- (Indicates a tin of issue 50 cigarettes)
- A. About that size but maybe couldn't contain as much as that.

- Q. Will you describe the immediate area surrounding the place and the road where you and the accused stopped your trucks that afternoon?
