BY-LAWS.

Written notice shall be sent by the Secretary to all members of the time and place of each meeting, sufficiently in advance of the time to enable them to attend.

The order of business at meetings shall be as follows:—

- 1. Signing of names by members present in the book kept for that purpose.
 - 2. Reading of minutes of previous meeting.
 - 3. Reading of minutes of Executive Council.
 - 4. Correspondence read and considered.
 - 5. Accounts.
 - 6. New members proposed.
 - 7. Reports of Committees.
 - 8. Unfinished business.
 - 9. Notice of motion.
 - 10. General business.

At meetings of the Society for the transaction of ordinary business five shall be a quorum. For election of members ten shall be a quorum. For any alterations of Constitution, the levy of money upon the members, or the expenditure of sums of money over two hundred dollars, ten shall be a quorum. At meetings of the Executive Council three shall be a quorum.

All motions must be in writing, with the Motions. names of the mover and seconder, and be de-
