## NOTICE.

HIS MAJESTY'S RECEIVER GENERAL will commence to pay on the Fourteenth Day of June next, to the undermentioned Persons, or their Assigns, Twenty-Five per Cent, on the Amount awarded by the Commission appointed by the Provincial Statute passed in the fourth year of His MAJESTY's Reign Cap. IV. for Losses sustained, during the late War with the United States of America, agreeable to the following Schedule.—

When the demand is made for Payment in Person, the individual will be required to produce an Affidavit, sworn before some one Justice of the Peace in this form:—

I, A. B. of the Town of \_\_\_\_\_ in the District of \_\_\_\_\_ do solemnly swear, on the Holy Evangelists, that my Claim was preferred on my behalf for Losses sustained during the late War with the United States of America, and that according to the best of my knowledge and belief, I am the person by the name of A. B. in whose favour a sum appears to have been allowed by the Commissioners, according to the Notice thereof published in the Upper Canada Gazette.

Sworn, &c.

When an Agent is authorised to receive the Payment, it is required that a Certificate shall be produced from some one Justice of the Peace in this form:—

I, A. B. of the Town of \_\_\_\_\_ in the District of \_\_\_\_\_ one of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace, do hereby certify, that I am acquainted with C. D. of the Town of \_\_\_\_\_ in the District of \_\_\_\_\_ who is a Claimant for Losses sustained in this Province during the late war with the United States of America, and who constituted his Attorney, (or Attorneys,) to act for him in obtaining payment of the same, as I have been informed, and believe that I have seen the said C. D. within the last past six months, and that I verily believe the said C. D. to be now living.
