FIFTY-SIX THOUSAND RE **GAME LICENSES**

unting in New Brunswick is report ed to be the best ever experienced as far as concerns the receipts paid into the provincial treasury from liense fees paid by hunters. A great nflux of non-resident hunters is the cause of the record total.

Col. T. G. Loggie, Deputy Minis ter of Lands and Mines, stated today that the receipts from the sale of game licenses had totalled \$56,000. The increase was about seven thousand dollars over the total of the preceding year.

Total Will be Increased


The total announced for the game season as the end of the financial year of the province comes on October 31st which is in the middle of the game season. November will provide a considerable number of game-license sales thus increasing the total'

Places of Sale

McAdam is lowning large as a place of sale of game licenses as many of the parties from the United States purchase their licenses at that place immediately after entering the province.. North Shore points also are reporting heavy sales of game-licenses. That is accounted for by the fact that an increasing number of parties from Middle Western States enter the province at those points, the ticket agents in the United States routing them over the C. N. R. via Montreal.

Revenue Gratifying

The revenue received by the prov nce from the Crown Lands in spite of the depressed state of the lumber market, have reached a most gratify ing total. Some payments have come in since October 31st but as the books of the province close on that day they will not be shown. The total from stumpage was about \$1,100,000
